Call for Papers

I. WORKSHOP GOALS

Within the framework of the XXVIII Conference of the Spanish Association of International Law and International Relations Professors, a Workshop of Young Internationalist Researchers will be held on the afternoon before the opening of the Conference.







This workshop is aimed at a maximum of 20 doctoral students and young doctors who have defended their doctoral thesis in 2018 or 2019 in any of the research areas of the Association.

The general aim of the workshop is to give these young researchers the opportunity to share their research with their peers, making their first contact with academics and receive feedback from internationalists whose research career is consolidated. This workshop will also offer the possibility of making contact with other researchers working in the same areas, strengthening scientific ties and sharing ideas and experience.

II. SUBMISSION AND ACCEPTANCE OF PROPOSALS

Those young researchers who wish to participate in the Workshop should send their proposal to the address <u>talleraepdiri2019@dipri.org</u> before **15 May 2019**.

In their proposal they should give their name, University of origin, year of doctoral programme (or defence of their thesis) and the subject of their presentation. The papers can present complete or partial empirical results, setting out specific methodological problems, as well as the research on specific lines of argumentation that they wish to develop or other scientific questions on which they need to obtain feed-back from senior researchers and other participants.

Each participant will have 10 minutes, of which no more than five may be devoted to the presentation of the specific theme, leaving time for debate. Participants will decide which format they want to use for their contributions, although innovative formats beyond the use of PowerPoint are welcome.

Once the proposals have been received, the Academic Committee, no later than **20 May 2019**, will communicate the selection of their proposal







and the specific characteristics of the Workshop's development to the chosen candidates.

The list of senior researchers who will participate in the International Young Researchers Workshop will be published soon.

The participation of the young researcher in the Workshop is subject to its effective registration in the XXVIII Conference.

III. AEPDIRI GRANTS FOR YOUNG INTERNATIONALISTS

The Association will support the participation of up to 20 young researchers in the Workshop with a grant not exceeding $150 \in$. These grants are only available for AEPDIRI members up to date on the Association fees and coming from Universities other that the hosting institution (University of Granada).

In the event that more than 20 proposals accompanied by an application for a grant are accepted, a Subcommittee of the Academic Committee and the Organizing Committee will select those candidates to receive a grant before **31 May 2019**, according to the following criteria:

- 1. Scientific quality of the proposal.
- 2. Originality and scientific innovation of the proposal.
- 3. Originality and innovation of the format of the presentation
